Web-based instruction is provided in a ratio of 1 tutor per 8 students for 2 hours per day, twice a week. Each student is given an assessment at the beginning of tutoring services to analyze areas in need of improvement. The student is then engaged in research-based instruction and assessment using the SkillsTutor online curriculum to improve in the needed areas. The SkillsTutor curriculum is aligned to the Michigan Grade Level Content Expectations in Language Arts/Reading and Math and the tutors at Know 2 Grow Learning are trained to help students, along with the support of teachers and parents, reach their academic goals while gaining self-confidence in an encouraging environment.
