Learn It Online provides math and reading instruction to grade K-8 students using our curricula, Learn It Reading™ and Learn It Math™. Students work in small online groups (up to 5 students) with a live instructor, using a computer and Internet connection provided by Learn It. All instructors are U.S. based. We strive to hire only certified teachers. At a minimum, Learn It requires our instructors have an Associate's Degree. To ensure that instruction is focused, intensive, and targeted to student needs, we administer a pre-assessment aligned to the Michigan state test and, using the results, create an Individual Student Learning Plan (ILP). The ILP outlines the instruction each student will receive, setting academic goals and a timetable for achievement for each student. Online sessions are 2-4 days a week lasting 60-120 minutes.
