SUBJECT: Fiscal Year (FY) 2015 Great Start Readiness Program (GSRP)
Opportunity for Migrant/Summer Services Funding

The Michigan Department of Education (MDE) is pleased to offer Intermediate School Districts (ISDs) the opportunity to accept additional GSRP slots to serve children during the summer of 2015.

In order to be eligible, children will need to meet GSRP income and age guidelines and have not attended a publicly-funded preschool in Michigan during FY 2015.

The ISD must agree to comply with all applicable Child Care Licensing rules and GSRP program requirements as modified for Migrant/Summer GSRP (see attached) in order to accept additional slots.

Please complete the attached form indicating if the ISD is interested or is not interested in receiving Migrant/Summer GSRP slots and submit it to:

This letter is not an official offer, but merely an inquiry of interest. After the due date, all requests will be compiled and offers of additional Migrant/Summer GSRP part-day slots will be made based on the existing ISD poverty ranking as outlined in the *GSRP Implementation Manual*.
