How MiPHY County/Regional Reports are generated:

- **School/district participation** - A minimum of at least **two districts** and at least **two building** types (middle school or high school) must participate for a county/regional report to generate.
- **Anonymous reporting** - Participating districts and schools are not identified in order to preserve confidentiality and to encourage community ownership of results and action.
- **Demographics** - Participation demographics will be provided with reports that include numbers and percent of participating districts and buildings as well as student demographics by grade, gender, race/ethnicity, and academics.
- **Regional reports** - Four areas in the state are merged for regional rather than county-level reports to preserve school anonymity and allow for more report availability. These areas are: Alpena-Montmorency-Alcona; Crawford-Oscoda-Ogemaw-Roscommon; Delta-Schoolcraft; Chippewa-Luce-Mackinac; and Mason-Lake.
