SUBJECT: Estimated Awards for the IDEA American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) Funds and IDEA Part B Special Education Regular Flowthrough Funds for FY 2009-2010

For your planning purposes, the attached chart shows your estimated awards for the IDEA ARRA funds and IDEA, Part B Special Education Regular Flowthrough funds for FY 2009-2010. Estimated awards are based on preliminary information we received from the United States Department of Education (USED) and FY 2008-2009 award data factors.

You will receive a formal Grant Award Notification from Superintendent Michael Flanagan, pending receipt of the federal grant awards from USED and final approval. Fifty percent (50%) of the IDEA ARRA funds will become available after review and approval of your grant application. Please note that your estimated amount will change based on the final grant award received from the USED and final audited 2008 count data.

You will be notified by listserv when the applications for the IDEA ARRA funds and IDEA Part B Special Education Regular Flowthrough funds will be available and ready for you to complete in the Michigan Electronic Grants System (MEGS).

Also attached is a document that provides guidance related to the IDEA Part B ARRA funds. - 1) Base Allocation = 75% of the FFY 1999 award to ISDs and allocated based on the 1998 December 1 Count
- 2) 85% of the remaining award is distributed on a pro rata basis according to K-12 Public Sept. 2007 Count & K-12 Non-Public Sept. 2007 Count
- 3) 15% of the remaining award is distributed on a pro rata basis according to the Oct. 2007 Free Lunch Count

The final awards will be calculated with 2008 count data once it is audited and becomes available.
