Great Parents, Great Start (GP,GS) services are developed so they align with, and are part of the broader local early childhood community collaborative plan. Many benefits have been gained from strengthening the coordination and collaboration between schools and communities.

3. Background/Purpose of Grant Program: GP,GS is a state-funded parenting program for all Michigan families with children age five or younger. This parenting program builds upon the knowledge and experience gained from All Students Achieve Program – Parent Involvement and Education (ASAP-PIE) Grants, available in 2000-2003, and the first eight years (2003-2011) of GP,GS Program Grants. The purpose of GP,GS Program Grants is to encourage early mathematics and reading literacy, improve school readiness, and foster the maintenance of stable families by encouraging positive parenting skills.
