

Background/Purpose of Grant Program: The purpose of this grant is to solicit applications from eligible applicants for planning, program design, and initial implementation for a period of up to 36 months, which the applicant may use not more than two (2) years for the initial implementation of a PSA. The purpose of this grant is to also encourage PSAs to document, develop and disseminate exemplary practices to public schools (including public charter schools) to promote increased student achievement. 


