**4. Target Population to be Served by Grant:**

Children eligible for the Great Start Readiness Program preschool must be at least four, but less than five years of age, as of December 1, 2012. Children served must be identified for eligibility as defined and approved by the State Board of Education on May 12, 2009. School districts and public school academies (PSAs) may provide parent involvement and education programs to families of all children birth to kindergarten entry.

**5. Eligible Applicants:**

Intermediate School Districts (ISDs) and consortia of ISDs are eligible to apply based on allocations calculated individually for each ISD that previously submitted a Comprehensive Community Needs and Resources Assessment (CNRA), which is the pre-application for this program.
