At Priority: My Education we strive to provide individualized tutoring sessions tailored to meet the needs of each student. We assess students at the beginning and end of each tutoring session to verify which concepts the student has mastered and which ones need reinforcement. The student's progress will be shared with their parents and teachers. Through the use of our dynamic and interactive Web-based tool, we are able to collect diagnostic, formative, and summative results for each student. The online learning is presented through a variety of instructional formats that are motivating and meet each student at his or her instructional level. A typical tutoring session will last 2 hours and will ideally take place Monday Through Saturday. Each class will have a ratio of 8 students per tutor, or 30 students per tutor if done exclusively online. Tutor's qualification will range from certified MI teachers to college students.
