

# 2012 MOSPA Conference Checklist

*Follow these helpful hints to ensure you are registered for this year's conference.*

- **Register early.** *Don't wait until the April 9 deadline. The conference may reach its capacity before this date.*
  
- **Mail your registration form to the address indicated.**

*Fax registrations are not accepted.*
  
- **Include payment with your registration; make your check payable to MOSPA.**  
*You are NOT registered until we have received your conference fee. Many ensure their payment by sending a personal check, then submitting expenses to their employer for reimbursement as your business office may delay sending the check. In the past the checks have been made to the wrong entity and are not valid until correctly submitted.*
  
- **Make sure your email address is clearly indicated on the form.**  
*It is necessary for you to receive an email confirmation of your registration. You are **not** registered until you have received email confirmation. If you have not received your email confirmation, contact Laurie Bates at 517-267-5810 or mospa\_bates@yahoo.com.  
**Bring your email confirmation to the conference.** *It will help in case there are any questions about your registration.**
  
- **If someone else is mailing your registration form and check, make sure they have done so in a timely manner.** *We do not want to turn you away at the door but will have to if we have not received your registration or payment.*
  
- **Book your room with the Inn early.** *If you delay, there might not be room for you to stay at this property. If you are coming with a group, you might want to consider one of the "cottages" adjacent to the Inn that can accommodate larger parties.*
  
- **Having a room reservation does **NOT** mean you are registered for the conference or vice versa.** *Some have thought that one took care of the other. To avoid any on-site hassles, be sure to reserve both the room and a space at the conference and bring your confirmations with you.*
  
- **Be aware that the Inn will charge your credit card for the first night when you make your reservation.**
