

This is a report card created by the Michigan Department of Education (MDE). Report cards are made for each company that tutored students during the 2010-2011 school year, in the program named Supplemental Education Services (SES).

The purpose of report cards is to give parents information to help them choose an SES tutor for their children in the coming school year. SES is a free tutoring program.

How Results Academic Explains Their Tutoring Program, in Their Own Words:

When a student signs up for our program an initial assessment is done via pre-testing. Based upon the individualized scores, each student is given a custom learning plan. This curriculum is based upon highly researched data that is systemic and goal driven. A standard session is a 120 minute session covering 30 – 45 minutes of each subject (based upon the parent/student choice). The ratio is 5:1 if face to face, 1:1 if a student has special needs or upon parental request, 8:1 if via technology usage or 25:1 if totally online. Our program offers instructional strategies and inhibitors to address the basic understanding needs of each child. We utilize Coach Products for Math, Reading & Science, SRA Corrective Reading and Math For Special Needs for the face to face programs. In addition, we utilize Oasis and Skills Tutor for technology and online programs. Each of our programs compliments each other by providing assistance to help nurture a student to increased test scores. Our preferred tutoring candidate is a Certified Teacher. Our minimal qualifications are at least a Masters Degree to tutor with specific courses taken in the subject matter being tutored.
