- SUBJECT: State Board of Education Policy on Reducing Student Suspensions and Expulsions

On May 13, 2014, the State Board of Education (SBE) adopted the "Policy on Reducing Student Suspensions and Expulsions." The SBE remains committed to policies that preserve the safest environment possible for all members of Michigan school communities. The policy is intended to be used as a guide to assist school districts as they develop their own policies to reduce suspensions and expulsions and keep students engaged in a rich learning environment.
