Program Description as Provided by National Alliance of Black School Educators (NABSE): NABSE's SES program is a combination of online individualized lessons and small group tutoring. The program is held on Saturday morning in the school's computer lab and provides students with three hours of structured tutoring in reading and math once a week. Each student receives 90 minutes of instruction in math and 90 minutes in reading. Half of each session is online, utilizing CompassLearning's Odyssey award-winning computer software. The other half of the session is dedicated to a variety of offline activities and small group tutoring sessions taught by a state-certified teacher. All lessons and activities target a student's individual academic needs. NABSE believes that parents must be partners in their child's education and to that end conducts a parent involvement workshop that runs at the same time as the SES program on Saturday morning. NABSE has a per-district minimum of 100 students in order to provide service.
