Program Description as Provided by Detroit Youth Foundation: The Detroit Youth Foundation (DYF) offers students in grades 6-12 tutoring in reading and mathematics. DYF will utilize computer based instruction and the direct instruction approach to deliver these tutorial services to students. Each tutoring session will be one hour in length and students will be provided with two sessions per week for each content area. Students will be pre-assessed prior to instruction with ongoing assessments given weekly. Caring, committed, certified teachers will work with students to insure success. With the aid of computerized assessments and formal and informal assessments, certified teachers will create individual goals for each student to achieve. Detailed records of each student's progress will be maintained, allowing for ongoing analysis of needs and areas of strength. Parents and teachers will be provided with weekly progress reports.
