

System


- Single Survey System

System

- Able to house multiple tools
- Updated technology
- Maintained what works/needs
- More complex system
- Requires training and technical support

  - ▣ Michigan School Climate Survey (MiSCAI)

# Safe and Supportive Schools Grant (S3) (2010)



- US Dept of Education grant to support positive climate change within schools as well as use a standardized survey tools to measure and guide decisions
- Schools were invited to participate and apply for the original S3 grant = 23 Michigan schools
  - All agreed to survey requirements by returning the Intent to Apply letters.



- New admin website – single point of access

- Able to survey students, staff, and parents
- Ability to preview actual survey screens
- Multiple surveys available
- Calculated data available in pdf and excel downloads
- Adaptations for staff and parent surveying
- Improvement in survey tracking
- Utilizes a question “bank” system
- Behind the scenes capabilities of system managers

# Bully-Free Schools (BFS)



- The SAPE developed survey for use with the Bully-Free Schools: Circle of Support systems change process
- Currently up and available
- Student (165 Qs) and Staff (100 Qs) Surveys
- Secondary: Any grades 5-12
- Reports available later in the Spring, similar to the O'Neill Consulting reports plus additional analysis
- Available each school year and to all schools

# Bully-Free Schools (BFS)

## Prevention of Bullying/Aggression

- Classroom approaches and behaviors of staff and students to stop bullying/aggression

## Bullying/Aggression

- Staff and student responses to witnessing different types of bullying
- Student being a target of bullying

## Reactions to Bullying/Aggression

- Student reaction to being a target
- Staff tolerance of bullying/aggression

# School Climate Assessment Indicator (MiSCAI)



- Work by John Shindler, California State University, Los Angeles, through his Transformative Connected School System (TCSS) and Alliance for the Study of School Climate (ASSC)
- Validated tool shows correlation between survey responses and standardized test scores
- Adapted for Michigan and S3 schools
- Uses a Scale system of questions
- Survey for Students, Staff, and **Parents**

# School Climate Assessment Indicator (MiSCAI) components

## 1. *Physical Appearance*

• Student - Staff - Parent

## 2. *Faculty Relations*

• Staff

## 3. *Student Interactions*

• Student - Staff - Parent

## 4. *Leadership/Decisions*

• Staff

## 5. *Discipline Environment*

• Student - Staff - Parent

## 6. *Learning/Assessment*

• Student - Staff - Parent

## 7. *Attitude and Culture*

• Student - Staff - Parent

# Now: Getting ready locally

## MiPHY

- Open in February
- Grades 7, 9, 11
- Take in Spring

## MiSCAI

- Open By Jan 31
- Any grade or opposite MiPHY (10, 12)
- Take in February/March

## BFS

- Open Now; Quick Start available
- Any grade or opposite MiPHY (10-12)
- Take Jan-Spring
