Skills of Success Tutoring Program is designed to help increase academic achievement in math and reading for students in grades 2-12. Our program will use the Direct Instruction Method approach. Students will have one hour of classroom instruction which will include differentiated lessons, lecture, drills and practices and one hour of computer-based instruction to re-enforce materials taught. Each session will be held 2 days a week for a total of 4 hours. Students will receive a total of 32 instructional hours. The teacher student ratio will be 1:5 for non computer-based instruction and a ratio of 1:8 for computer based instruction. The S.O.S Tutoring Program integrates financial literacy, mathematics, reading and technology. The Banking Your Skills and Study Island instructional materials that will be used are aligned to Michigan Grade Level Content Expectations. Tutors are experienced and possess at least a four year degree.
