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Update Your Entity Contact Information in the EEM

The Educational Entity Master (EEM) is used throughout the year to pull contact information for schools and districts for important communications. It is also used to pull various information about your school and/or district for assessment and accountability reporting purposes. It is crucial that your school and/or district keep your entity and entity contact information up to date in the EEM at http://www.mi.gov/eem.

Keeping your EEM information up-to-date is the best way to ensure that the MDE will use correct entity and entity contact information for your school and/or district. To update information in your EEM listing(s), please consult your school or district authorized EEM user.

Test Tickets for M-STEP and MI-Access Online Assessments

All Spring 2015 M-STEP and MI-Access online assessments* will require student test tickets to allow access to the online tests. Once a student has started an online test session, the student has until the end of the instructional day to complete the test session. Online test tickets expire at the end of the instructional day on which testing was started and cannot be reused on subsequent days. For tests with more than one test ticket, each test ticket may be used on separate days. Please use the charts below to see how many test tickets will need to be issued to each student testing online for each content area, type of test, and test component.

* MI-Access Supported Independence (SI) and Participation (P) assessments will require test tickets for the online answer documents that must be completed by the Primary Assessment Administrator.

Student Keyboard Shortcuts for INSIGHT

For many students, the use of keyboard commands (as opposed to a mouse) is the most efficient method through which to respond to many item types. In an effort to ensure students and test administrators are familiar with and have access to the keyboard commands that can be used within the INSIGHT system, a document of keyboard shortcuts is provided on eDIRECT at https://mi.drcedirect.com/default.aspx in the *Documents* section. Be sure to set the Administration type to *All* when you do a search for the document.

M-STEP Mathematics Calculator

Calculators **ARE NOT** allowed even as an accommodation in the grades 3–5 online or paper/pencil M-STEP Mathematics assessments. Even if the use of a calculator is identified as a need in a student's IEP or 504 plan in these grades, it would be a non-standard accommodation. Please refer to the Supports and Accommodations Table <u>http://www. mi.gov/documents/mde/M-STEP_Supports_and_</u> <u>Accommodations_Table_477120_7.pdf</u> for more information related to the grades and content areas in which calculators could be made available to students with as an identified need in their IEP or 504 plan.

Students with Prohibitive Behavior on ACT still required to take the M-STEP

Students who have been marked Prohibited Behavior on the ACT Plus Writing exam may not retake the ACT Plus Writing exam during makeup testing. However, students should and are expected to take the M-STEP component of the MME this year for accountability purposes.

Spring 2015 M-STEP Online Testing Window

We have received questions from schools regarding the test dates for online testing. The testing windows have not changed in any way, but we are providing the information below for clarification that schools administering the Spring 2015 M-STEP online have the flexibility to schedule students and tests to be administered **on any instructional day** during the testing window designated for each grade level. Please make note of the schedule below:

- Grades 5 and 8: the online tests may be administered on any instructional day April 13 – May 1, 2015
- Grades 4 and 7: the online tests may be administered on any instructional day April 27 – May 15, 2015

- Grades 3 and 6: the online tests may be administered on any instructional day May 18 – June 5, 2015
- Grade 11: the online tests may be administered on any instructional day **April 13 June 5, 2015**
- MI-Access Alternate Assessments—all grades: the online tests may be administered on any instructional day April 13 – May 29, 2015
