How Super Achievers Explains Their Tutoring Program, in Their Own Words:

Super Achievers offers students, grades K – 12, an opportunity to reach their highest academic and personal potential. Students work to achieve a set of individual short- and long-term goals in Reading, Math and Science. Goals are developed from test results, as well as from discussions with parents and school staff. Tutors meet with students after school, at students' schools, or in libraries, churches, or community centers. Tutoring sessions are offered twice per week, approximately 1 ½ hours per session. We tutor in groups of up to 5 students, or one-on-one, using SkillsTutor's guided online instruction. At each session, students' progress is measured by quizzes and tutor observations; parents and school staff receive information on student progress in monthly reports. Tutors hold a minimum of an Associate's degree, or equivalent, in Reading, Math or Science and have at least 3 years experience working with youth.
