Sylvan Learning seeks to partner with area school districts in order to help students that have been identified by the State of Michigan to develop essential reading and mathematical skills. Sylvan Learning will assess the needs of each student through an assessment to determine specific academic strengths and weaknesses. Each participant will have an individual learning plan designed around the specific needs identified through the assessment. This program will be taught in the traditional Sylvan method, with each students' progress based on skill mastery determined by scores earned through daily work. Instructional materials are provided for the student based on each individual lesson plan. At the completion of 36 hours, students participating in either Reading or Math programs will be given a final progress assessment to determine overall growth. Each session will range from 1-4 hours and 2-5 visits per week.
