How Sylvan Learning of South Canton and Brownstown Explains Their Tutoring Program, in Their Own Words:

The MDE has not edited this description.

Sylvan Learning Center will partner with local school districts to help students develop essential reading and mathematical skills. Each student begins a program with an assessment to determine specific academic strengths and weaknesses. An individualized learning plan is developed for each student based on the results of the Sylvan assessment. Students progress through their program based on mastery of learning goals. Progress is monitored on a daily basis by certified teachers. Conferences are held with the parent after the initial assessment and once monthly thereafter. Students are given a progress assessment at the completion of 36 hours of instruction. Instructional materials are provided based on a student's individual learning goals. Students attend two to four hours per week. There will be a maximum of three students to each teacher.
