

**Administrative Rules Governing the Certification of Michigan Teachers
Summary of Recent Changes**

PART 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS	
390.1101	<p>Definitions</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Updates definitions used within the rule set by including new terms and eliminating outdated terms.
390.1105	<p>Persons Required to hold Certificates or Permits</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clarifies that a legal guardian who home schools his or her own children is not required to hold certification. • Allows a school district to employ a non-certificated teacher to teach a Native American tribal language and culture class pursuant to section 1531f of 1976 PA 451, MCL 380.1531f.
391.1111	<p>Equality of opportunity</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Adds reference to preparing teachers with knowledge and experiences that support the vision and principles for universal education. • Adds crimes described in MCL 380.1535a(2) as sufficient grounds for denial of a teaching certificate or state board approval.
390.1115	<p>Applications; semester Credit Hours</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Adds alternate route providers.
390.1117	<p>Certificate Restrictions and Expiration</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Adds professional temporary teacher employment authorization. • Changes the expiration date of permits and authorizations to August 31 of the school year. • Clarifies that permanent, life, continuing and full vocational authorizations do not expire.
390.1118	<p>Nullification of Teaching Certificate</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Removes redundant language and references section 1532 of 1976 PA 451, MCL 380.1532.
PART 2. STATE PROVISIONAL AND INTERIM CERTIFICATES	
390.1121	<p>General Provisions (State Special Permits)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Adds alternate route providers. • States that teacher preparation institutions may have additional requirements that exceed the rules.
390.1122	<p>General Education; Approved Planned Program or Equivalent</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Adds structured field experience before student teaching with diverse student populations and in diverse instructional settings. • Adds applicants who complete an approved alternate route program meet the requirements under this rule.
380.1122a (New Rule)	<p>State Interim Teaching Certificates</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Adds requirements for the interim teaching certificate pursuant to section 1531i of 1976 PA 451, MCL 380.1531i.
390.1123	<p>Professional Education</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Adds requirements for alternate route programs. • Adds reading instruction requirements. • Clarifies alternate route applicants meet field experience or student teaching requirement as described in R 390.1124.
390.1124	<p>Scholastic Averages; Directed Teaching</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Defines the requirements for directed teaching for alternate route program candidates.
390.1125	<p>Degree and Recommendations</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Adds requirements for alternate route program providers.

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390.1126	<i>State Elementary Provisional Certificates</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Clarifies the validity of elementary teaching certificates and certificate endorsements and the grades in which they can be taught.
390.1127	<i>State Secondary Provisional Certificates</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Clarifies the validity of secondary teaching certificates and certificate endorsements and the grades in which they can be taught.
390.1128	<i>Additional Subject Area Endorsements</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Rescinds rule as it is redundant to R 390.1129
390.1129	<i>Additional Certificate Endorsements</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Explains the process for adding subject area endorsements to a currently valid teaching certificate.
390.1129a	<i>Procedures at Expiration of Provisional Certificate; before September 1, 2013</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Changes "temporary vocational authorization" to "interim occupational" certificate and clarifies renewal requirements. Revises requirements for the two-year extended provisional and interim occupational certificate.
390.1129b (New Rule)	<i>Procedures at Expiration of Provisional Certificates; effective September 1, 2013</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Adds new requirements for renewal of the Provisional certificate based on completion of 6 semester credit hours or 180 clock hours of state continuing education hours beginning September 1, 2013. Retains requirements for issuance of a 2-year extended provisional or interim occupational certificate.
380.1130	<i>Reciprocity</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Adds requirement of three years of successful teaching for reciprocity for out-of-state alternate route programs.
PART 3. STATE PROFESSIONAL EDUCATION, PERMANENT, AND CONTINUING CERTIFICATES	
390.1132	<i>State Elementary or Secondary Professional Education Certificates</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Specifies requirements before and after September 1, 2013. Adds the diagnostic reading requirement for the professional education certificate. Adds 5 year expiration for an initial professional education certificate.
390.1134	<i>Validity of Permanent and Continuing Certificates and Full Vocational Authorizations</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Eliminates the reinstatement of these certificates and clarifies that they do not expire.
390.1135	<i>Professional Education Certificate or Occupational Education Certificate; renewal</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Explains the process for renewing a professional or occupational education certificate. Adds 5 year expiration on these certificates.
390.1137 (New Rule)	<i>Advanced Professional Education Certificate</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Establishes the requirements for the optional third tier Advanced Professional Education certificate.
390.1138 (New Rule)	<i>Advanced Professional Education Certificate; renewal</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Establishes the requirements for the renewal of the advanced Professional Education certificate.
PART 4. STATE SPECIAL PERMITS	
390.1141	<i>General Provisions</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Adds when an application for a permit is submitted and dates permit is valid.
390.1142	<i>Full-Year Permits</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Adds mentor teacher requirements.

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390.1143	<i>Substitute Permits</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Minor word change.
390.1145	<i>Permits in Emergency Situations</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Provides that emergency permits would only be issued if the position has been posted and advertised extensively.
390.1146	<i>Permits; Noncertificated; Nonendorsed</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Eliminates redundant language already provided pursuant to section 1233b of 1976 PA 451, MCL 380.1233b.
390.1147 (New Rule)	<i>Expert in Residence Permits</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Creates a new permit for individuals to teach specific subjects for two or less hours a day in grades 9-12 if they hold a BA or higher degree and have demonstrated unusual distinction or exceptional talent in the field of specialization that will be taught.
PART 5. TEACHER PREPARATION INSTITUTIONS	
390.1151	<i>Approved Teacher Preparation Institutions and Programs</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Requires approved teacher preparation institutions to hold national accreditation by December 31, 2013.
390.1152	<i>Approved Teacher Preparation Institutions; Equivalence Option</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Replaces "specialty" with "certificate."
390.1154	<i>Out-of-State Institutions and Teacher Candidates</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Eliminates redundant language already provided pursuant to section 1531 of 1976 PA 451, MCL 380.1531. Adds temporary teacher employment authorization pursuant to section 1531 of 1976 PA 451, MCL 380.1531. Clarifies requirements of an out-of-state applicant.
380.1155	<i>Non-Teacher Preparation Institutions</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Rescinds rule as it is unnecessary.
390.1156	<i>Distance Learning and Online Learning</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Adds online learning.
PART 6. OCCUPATIONAL ENDORSEMENT AND AUTHORIZATION	
390.1161	<i>State Secondary Provisional Certification with Occupational Endorsement</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Replaces "vocational" with "occupational."
390.1162	<i>State Secondary Professional Education Certification with Vocational Endorsement</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Replaces "vocational" with "occupational." Explains requirements for issuance of Professional Education Certificate with Occupational Endorsement effective September 1, 2013.
390.1163	<i>Interim Occupational Certificate</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Replaces "vocational" with "occupational." Clarifies expiration of certificate.
390.1164a	<i>Occupational Education Certificates</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Clarifies requirements for an interim occupational certificate or temporary vocational authorization before and after September 1, 2013.
390.1165	<i>Annual Occupational Authorizations</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Requires local districts to post and advertise occupational education positions prior to applying for the annual occupational authorization. Clarifies the requirements of noncertificated teacher under an annual occupational authorization.
390.1166	<i>Credit from Institutions Not Designated for Preparation of Occupational Teachers</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Replaces "vocational" with "occupational."
390.1167	<i>Instructional Programs Leading to State or Federal License</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Replaces "vocational" with "occupational."
