Quality Competitive Grants Program

The Michigan Department of Education (MDE) is authorized to award approximately \$285,000 for the Title II, Part A(3) Improving Teacher Quality Competitive Grants Program.

The focus of this request for applications is on the provision of research-based professional learning opportunities to teachers, principals, and paraprofessionals, which will result in increased learning for all students. These grants are available to higher education departments of teacher education in partnership with higher education departments of arts and sciences and high-poverty local education agencies. Please pay special attention to the priorities and funding criteria in the application package.

The purpose of these grants is to support partnerships in the provision of professional learning opportunities needed to achieve the goal of having excellent educators in all classrooms with deep knowledge of the content they are assigned to teach and instructional delivery skills to meet learning needs of all students.
