Total Package 180 Mentoring & Tutoring program was founded by national day time TV personality Raphael B. Johnson who is known for turning around the lives of out-of-control teens on the Maury Show. This unique combination of tutoring and mentoring (Conflict Resolution Education (CRE)) promotes School-wide Positive Behavior Support (PBS) and leads to improvement academically & socially. Students will be (1) pre-tested, (2) tutored/mentored (using our primary & supplemental materials), (3) post-tested, and (4) will participate in an award closing ceremony. We will use one-on-one, small group, web-based instruction (Study Island) and multilevel instruction to ensure the success of all students. We will provide 3 days per week of tutoring services, 2 hours per session for maximum of 25 hours. Qualifications for teachers include a 4 year college degree, with a valid or temporary teaching certificate, w/particular expertise working with Title I students and/or students from challenging socioeconomic backgrounds as well as students w/Disabilities. We may also hire tutors who have 2 year Associate's degree or who have 60 or more college credit hours.
