Re: School Nutrition Programs Update Meeting

1. Go to Workshop Registration at: https://mdoe.state.mi.us/fs_registration/.
2. Click on *Register For A Workshop*.
3. Click on the appropriate box to identify whether you are from an LEA/ISD/PSA or from an organization.
4. Click on down arrow to choose your desired workshop. *Click on School Nutrition Programs Update Meeting*, and then click *Next*.
5. If you are registering from an LEA/ISD/PSA:
Click on down arrow to indicate your local ISD, and then click *Next*.
Click on down arrow to indicate your local district, and then click *Next*.
6. If registering from an organization, fill in organization name, and then click *Next*.

Your registration is NOT complete until you click *Confirm*.






Kent ISD Campus



Directions to our Kent ISD campus at 2930 Knapp NE:

From the SOUTH, take 131 to Grand Rapids, then head east on 196. Exit at the East Beltline, (which is just beyond where 96 and 196 merge). On the exit ramp stay in one of the left lanes and turn left (north) at the top of the exit ramp onto the East Beltline. Continue north past the Frederik Meijer Gardens, past Leonard Street, past the big Meijer store complex to Knapp Street. Turn left (west) onto Knapp (the whole Beltline is a boulevard, so you have to do the "turnaround" in order to actually turn left). Kent ISD is the next business after Meijer, so you'll see our sign on the left once you pass the side entrances of Meijer. The Educational Service Center will be the first building, Parking Lot 11.


From the NORTH, take 96 east to the Leonard Street exit. Turn left (east) and go to Leffingwell Street and turn left (north). You can enter the middle of the campus directly from Leffingwell (closest to the Tech Center and Transition Center) or go to the light at Knapp Street, turn right (east) and enter the campus off Knapp, which is closest to the Educational Service Center building, Parking Lot 11.

From the EAST, take 96 to Grand Rapids and exit at the East Beltline. Turn right (north) at the top of the exit ramp. Continue north past the Frederik Meijer Gardens, past Leonard Street, past the big Meijer store complex to Knapp Street. Turn left (west) onto Knapp (the whole Beltline is a boulevard, so you have to do the "turnaround" in order to actually turn left). Kent ISD is the next business after Meijer, so you'll see our sign on the left once you pass the side entrances of Meijer. The Educational Service Center will be the first building, Parking Lot 11.

From the WEST, take 196 and go east to Grand Rapids. Just beyond where 196 and 96 merge, exit at the East Beltline exit. On the exit ramp stay in one of the left lanes and turn left (north) at the top of the exit ramp onto the East Beltline. Continue north past the Frederik Meijer Gardens, past Leonard Street, past the big Meijer store complex to Knapp Street. Turn left (west) onto Knapp (the whole Beltline is a boulevard, so you have to do the "turnaround" in order to actually turn left). Kent ISD is the next business after Meijer, so you'll see our sign on the left once you pass the side entrances of Meijer. The Educational Service Center will be the first building, Parking Lot 11.

Note: If your destination is Kent Career Technical Center (Parking Lot 1) or Kent Transition Center (Parking Lot 7), you may also enter the campus directly from the East Beltline, following the signs about halfway between Leonard and Knapp streets. You will get into the left lane and cross the Beltline.

Oakland Schools Main Building and Summit Campus



Oakland Schools is located at 2114 Pontiac Lake Road, Waterford, MI 48328-2738. We are on the southwest corner of Telegraph and Pontiac Lake Road, with the entrance on the south side of Pontiac Lake Road.

The Oakland Schools Summit Campus is located at 2214 Mall Drive East, Waterford, MI 48328-3321, and can be accessed via Telegraph, County Center Drive, and the main campus parking lot.

From the North

Take I-75 south and exit at Dixie Highway (Exit 50). (Please note that Dixie Highway also has an exit just south of Flint that exits on the left.) Turn right onto Dixie Highway and travel west approximately eight (8) miles to Telegraph Road. Turn right onto Telegraph Road. Travel approximately one (1) mile south, and make another right onto Pontiac Lake Road. Oakland Schools is the three-story, glass building on your left.

From the South

Travel north on Telegraph Road (through the Bloomfield Hills and Pontiac areas, passing Square Lake Road, Vocofais Road, Huron Street/M-59 and Elizabeth Lake Road). Continue north on Telegraph, passing the Summit Place Mall on your left. The next major intersection will be Pontiac Lake Road, and you need to get into the right lane. Go straight through the light and take the exit immediately on the right to Pontiac Lake Road. This will take you in a circle around to the right, back across Telegraph. Once you are through the light, Oakland Schools is the three-story, glass building on your left.

From the East


Take M-59 west until it exits into the Pontiac area. You will need to make a left on Perry Street and then a right to continue on M-59/Huron Street. Travel through downtown Pontiac to Telegraph Road, turning right onto Telegraph. Pass Elizabeth Lake Road and Summit Place Mall on your left. As you approach the next major intersection (Pontiac Lake Road) move into the right lane. Go straight through the light and immediately circle around to the right on the exit for Pontiac Lake Road. Oakland Schools is the three-story, glass building on your left.

From the West

Take M-59/Highland Road east to Pontiac Lake Road making sure you have passed the Oakland County International Airport. (Note: There is another intersection of M-59/Highland and Pontiac Lake Road further west but you don't want to turn there. You want to turn onto Pontiac Lake Road after you have passed Oakland County International Airport). Turn left onto Pontiac Lake Road. Oakland Schools will be located on your right approximately two (2) miles away. It is the three-story, glass building on your right. If you reach Telegraph Road, you've gone too far.

**DIRECTIONS TO
MARQUETTE-ALGER RESA
321 E. Ohio Street, Marquette, MI 49855**

Coming in on West U.S. 41 stay to the left past the Holiday Inn and go into the light on Washington St. Take Washington St. to Front St. (4 more stoplights) Turn left on Front St. and go past the Landmark Inn for 3 blocks; then turn right on Ohio Street. Go to the next stop sign (2 blocks) and then continue down the hill. MARESA is on the left. Turn left at the bottom of the hill.

Coming in on South U.S. 41 go straight ahead. South 41 will turn into Front Street. Go up the hill on Front St. past the Landmark Inn for 3 blocks to Ohio Street. Turn right on Ohio Street and go to the next stop sign (2 blocks) and then continue down the hill. MARESA is on the left. Turn left at the bottom of the hill.


