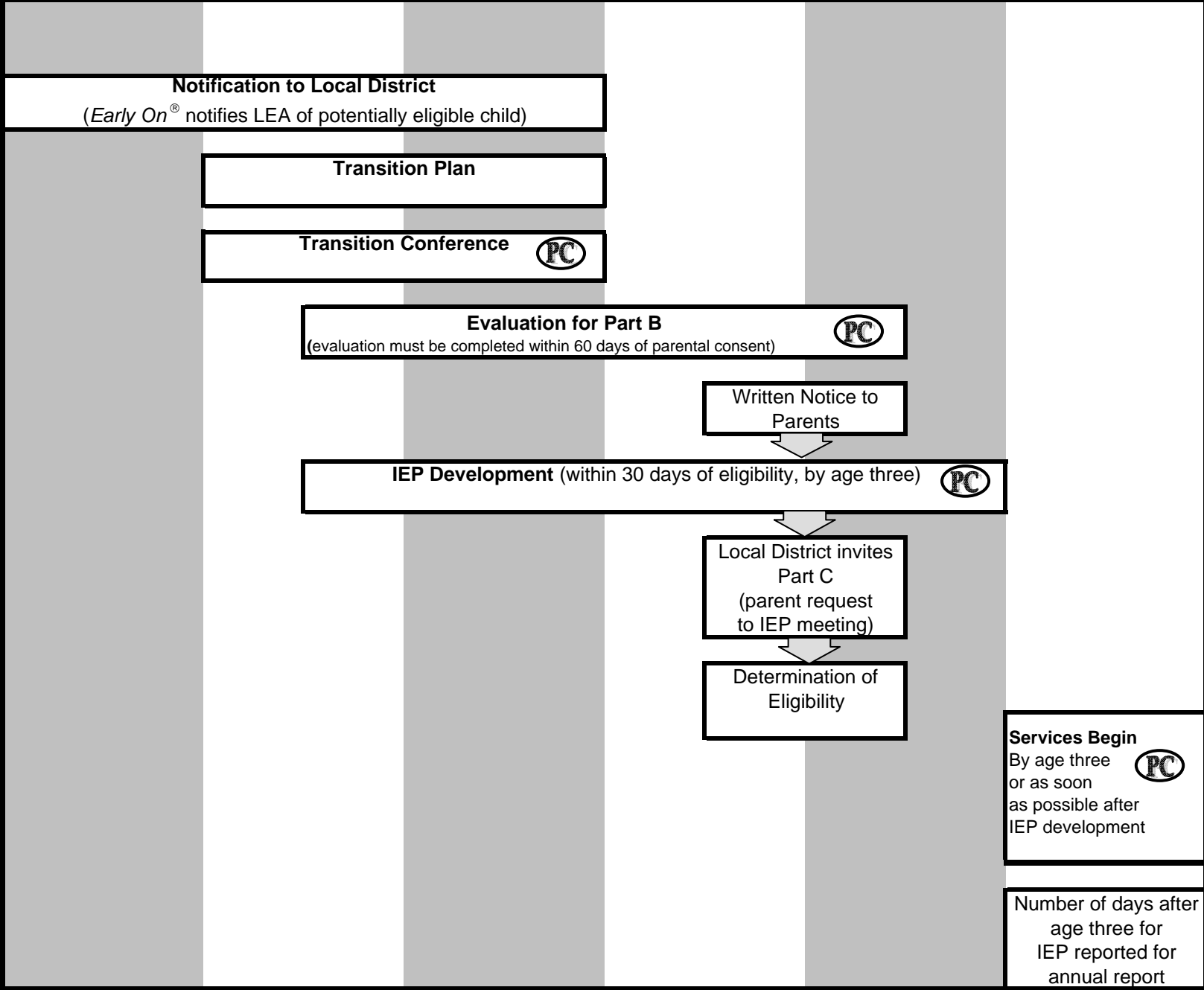

Definitions

Transition Plan -
Transition planning is an ongoing process while a child is enrolled in *Early On*. The child's service coordinator discusses steps and services with his/her family and helps the family gather information about transition options in their community. It may occur as early as nine months prior to their third birthday, but must occur at least 90 days before the child's third birthday. A transition plan must be completed for all children exiting *Early On*.

Transition Conference -
If the family chooses to be referred for Early Childhood Special Education, *Early On* will convene a meeting between current providers, the family, and district representatives (local district and lead agency). The purpose of the meeting is to plan for the child's transition, to help families know what lies ahead and what they can do to make the process move smoothly.
