The program will operate Monday thru Thursday from 4:00 to 6:00, Saturday 9:00am to 12:00 pm. On-line tutoring in both English and math will be accessible to students 24 hours a day using Skills Tutor software aligned with the National Education standards and the Michigan Curriculum framework.
