# ACCESS 2.0



- Grade level clusters
- K remains p/p
- Tier assignment
- Online: 1, 2-3, 4-5, 6-8, 9-12
- Paper-Pencil: K, 1, 2, 3, 4-5, 6-8, and 9-12
- No tier designation in advance of testing

- ELs who are also Students with Disabilities
- General rule
- Grade level clusters
- No tiers
- Proficiency Levels
- Remaining p/p
- Cognitive disabilities
- Students without an IEP/504 are not eligible to take this assessment
- 1-2, 3-5, 6-8, and 9-12
- A1, A2, A3, P1, P2, and P3
- Initiating, Exploring, Engaging, Entering, Emerging, Developing
