Consequences of Underage Drinking in Michigan Youth

Risky Sexual Behavior

Risky Sexual Behavior 2-4 times more common in Current Drinkers.


- 69% of current drinkers have had sex compared to 29% of nondrinkers.
- 55% of current drinkers have had sex in the past three months compared to 20% of nondrinkers.
- 26% of current drinkers had four or more sexual partners compared to 6% of nondrinkers.
- 7% of current drinkers have had sex before age
 13 compared to 3% of nondrinkers.
- 13% of current drinkers had first sexual intercourse with a partner who was three or more years older compared to 5% of nondrinkers.
- 8% of current drinkers have been pregnant at least once or caused one or more pregnancies compared to 3% of nondrinkers.
- 15% of current drinkers have been physically forced to have sex compared to 6% of nondrinkers.

Youth Protective Factors


- Current drinkers & nondrinkers had similar rates of condom and birth control pill use.
- Approximately 70% of current & nondrinkers have had discussions with their parents or other adults in their family about expected sexual behavior.

"Nondrinkers" reported not drinking any alcohol in the past 30 days. "Current drinkers" reported having at least one drink of alcohol in the past 30 days. "Youth" are 9th-12th grade students attending Michigan public high schools.
