Your Financial Insight's "Banking Your Skills" (BYS) Tutoring Program is designed to help increase academic achievement in math for students in 6th, 7th, and 8th grade. Our program will use the Direct Instruction Method approach. The BYS program integrates financial literacy, mathematics and technology. The BYS program will be offered during the academic year. Each session will be held 2 days a total of 2 hours per week. Students will have one hour of classroom instruction which will include differentiated lessons, lecture, drills and practices and one hour of computer-based instruction to re-enforce materials taught. Students will receive a total of 32 sessions. All materials provided will be aligned to Michigan Grade Level Content Expectations. Classes will be held at a location that is accessible for students (school, community center, etc.). A minimum of 25 students must enroll in order to serve a LEA and a maximum of 200.
