iLEARNED takes an individualized approach of 1:1 tutoring tailored to MDE and MEAP standards. The student uses an interactive whiteboard where worksheets are worked on in an online real-time collaborative environment. Tutors see what the student is doing and can easily send supplementary material immediately if the student does not understand the topic. Interaction is also via online voice/text chat. This allows multiple touchpoints between tutor and student and allows the student to review the session afterwards. This is especially helpful as the student's learning continues even after the session. Typical sessions are 1 hour with 5 minutes in the beginning to quickly review past material and 5 minutes at the end to answer questions. Students improve academic achievement because they progress at their own pace with a personal tutor watching every step and able to correct mistakes immediately.
