## NOTE: Implementation of this policy is contingent upon State Plan Amendment approval from the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS).

The Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) will modify the underlying data it uses to allocate payments from the outpatient MACI pools. MDHHS has historically used Fee-for-Service (FFS) outpatient hospital payments from hospital cost reports with fiscal years ending during the second previous state fiscal year to allocate payment shares from this pool. Beginning in State fiscal year 2016, to determine each hospital's share of an outpatient hospital MACI pool, MDHHS will use paid claims for the fiscal year ending two years prior to the current fiscal year. Claims will be restricted to those paid by June 30th of the following year. For example, paid claims from fiscal year 2014 paid by June 30, 2015 will be used to allocate the fiscal year 2016 MACI payments.

The paid claims file will include all Medicaid FFS claims payments made for both Medicaid and CSHCS eligible beneficiaries. Paid claims will include those with other insurance and patient-pay amounts. Outpatient services will include both acute and rehabilitation services. Graduate Medical Education (GME), and Disproportionate Share Hospital (DSH) payments will not be included in the paid claims file used to distribute the outpatient MACI pools.

The only change imposed by this policy is the data source used to allocate the outpatient MACI pools.
