



Changes for 2016 AFIX Site Visits

- 1. Reviewer Information:** The AFIX Online Tool requires education level of the reviewer. For all reviewers that have an RN license. Select “*Other please specify*” and enter RN along with the education level. Example: RN, AND (RN with an Associate Nursing Degree) RN, BSN (RN with Bachelor Science Nursing degree)
- 2. Questionnaire:** The selected QI is now available for selection at both the Childhood and the Adolescent separately. Once a QI is selected, expand QI steps will appear. QI Steps can be used to further support the QI area selected. The QI selected and the QI steps selected will auto populate the QI action plan.
- 3. Quality Improvement Action Plans.** The 2016 AFIX Online Tool has the Quality Improvement Action Plan programmed into the questionnaire tab. The **QI action plan** will auto populate with the checked QI areas and the action steps, *after SAVE is clicked.*
- 4. Pediatric vaccine series.** The AFIX Online Tool will contain fields for two pediatric vaccine series; 4313314 and 43133142. Please assure that the proper coverage level is entered into the proper field. *As of February 5, 2016, the 43133142 is not yet available for data entry.*
- 5. AFIX Follow Up Visits.** The eXchange tab contains information for AFIX Follow Up visits. It is recommended that AFIX Follow Up visits occur at the minimum *3 months from the date of the site visit.* They are required to be conducted within 6 months from the date of site visit. *The method of AFIX Follow Up visits (in person at the provider office or via a phone call) is now entered on the eXchange tab.*

2016 AFIX Site Visit Reminders:

- 1. Generate AFIX Basic Overview Reports prior to site visit.**
 - a. Pediatric AFIX Reports 24-36 months old
 - i. 43133142 vaccine series (*must be on one AFIX report*)
 - ii. **4313314 vaccine series** (*must be on one AFIX report*)
 - iii. 1 seasonal influenza (*must be on one AFIX report*)
 - iv. RV can be generated if desired
 - b. Adolescent AFIX Reports 156-216 months old – change in required vaccines
 - i. **1 Tdap, 1 MCV and 3 HPV are required** for all adolescent AFIX visits
The 3 doses HPV *must be on one AFIX report by itself*
 - ii. 3 HepB, 2MMR, 2Var, 2HPV, 1HPV, 1 Flu, 2 HepA, 3 Polio is recommended and encouraged
- 2. Enter data and information into the AFIX Online Tool prior to site visit**
 - a. Print Summary from the AFIX Online Tool and take to provider office for discussion and review.
 - b. Changes can be made at the site visit and then entered in the AFIX Online Tool afterwards.
