MCSP NEWSBLAST: Revised Cancer Reporting Requirements for Electronic Submission of Data to the MCSP

Introduction

The Michigan Cancer Surveillance Program (MCSP) revised the submission of data reporting requirements for electronic cancer case reporting to the Michigan cancer registry effective on January 1, 2016.

Electronic submission of data to the MCSP ***on or after January 1, 2016*** must be submitted through Web Plus.

ALL data submissions uploaded to the MCSP FTP site ***on or after January 1, 2016*** must be resubmitted to the MCSP through Web Plus.

Web Plus

What is Web Plus? It is a Web-based application that collects cancer data securely over the public Internet. Web Plus is ideal for use by central cancer registries for all electronic reporting needs. It supports three main functions: online abstracting, file upload and download, and follow-back efforts. Web Plus' online abstracting capability is ideal for low-volume reporting sources, while the file upload feature can be used for electronic submission of data from all other reporting sources to the central cancer registry.

- The two features currently available in the MCSP Web Plus application includes file upload and download.
- The Online Abstracting function will be released after the MCSP converts to NAACCR format version 16.

Users, display types and edit configurations in the Michigan Web Plus application are managed by the MCSP. The edit configuration includes the MCSP Edit Set

- A copy of the MCSP Edit Set can be obtained using the Download function in Web Plus
- Currently available – MCSP Edit Set revised March 1, 2016

MCSP NEWSBLAST: 2016 Submission of Data Due Dates

ALL reportable conditions diagnosed on or before September 30, 2015 are due to the MCSP **on or before April 1, 2016**.

ALL reportable conditions diagnosed through December 31, 2015 are due to the MCSP **on or before July 1, 2016**.

Facilities submitting electronic submission of data to the MCSP are required to submit data on a monthly basis.

Facilities submitting data via the MCSP Cancer Report Form are required to submit reportable conditions within 6 months (180 days) from the date of initial diagnosis and/or first course of treatment. Facilities non-compliant with the Michigan cancer reporting requirements will be addressed and corrective action take as necessary.
