Dear Mr. Priest:

I am writing to inform you that the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) has approved your title XXI Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) state plan amendment (SPA) number MI-16-0005, submitted on March 1, 2016. This SPA relates to Modified Adjusted Gross Income (MAGI) Eligibility. It has an effective date of March 1, 2016.

Michigan's SPA number MI-16-0005 is approved to further the Flint, Michigan demonstration project authorized under section 1115 of the Act (Project No. 11W00302/5) and will begin when the demonstration authority is approved and end when the demonstration authority expires. Michigan covers individuals under age 21 up to 400 percent of the federal poverty level (FPL) under the optional coverage group described at 1902(a)(10)(A)(ii)(XX) of the Act ("the XX group"). Coverage reflected in this SPA reflects the availability of enhanced FMAP under title XXI of the Social Security Act for uninsured children ages 0 to 19 who are covered under this optional group with income up to 300 percent FPL, specific to the Flint, Michigan demonstration project.

This SPA does not supersede Michigan's SPA number MI-15-0003, which amended its existing MAGI-equivalent standards, by age and income level, for children up to and including 212 percent of the FPL covered in its title XXI-funded Medicaid expansion program, effective January 1, 2016. Through Michigan's SPA number MI-15-0003, the state plan page (CS3) will allow the state to claim title XXI match against its CHIP allotment for children who transitioned to its Medicaid expansion program.
