### SUMMARY OF KEY POINTS

**Introductions and Welcome:** Larry opened the meeting and participants introduced themselves. He also introduced the new SPF/PFS 2015-2020 project director, Kelli Martin, who will soon be in charge of this meeting. Kelli will also be working with Su Min on EPI. Kelli informed every one of her background. **NOTE:** This group is also the advisory group for the SPF/PFS 2015-2020. Attendance attached.

**Approval of Agenda:** Approved by consensus.

**Minutes:** The minutes of December 3, 2015 were reviewed and approved by consensus.

#### **OROSC UPDATES – Larry Scott**

- Overall updates

**Request for Information (RFI)** - Larry passed out a document on a Request for Information (RFI) that was sent to the PIHPs regarding Block Grant funding available for prevention and treatment. He also explained items on the document, such as the eight (8) focus areas, budget, programmatic areas, etc. Each PIHP can apply for all eight (8) focus areas if the need exists. This document will be e-mailed to everyone.

**Children's Services Administration (CSA)** - Met with CSA about implementation with our ROSC and how they can interact with our service delivery system in the areas of substance use disorder (SUD) issues. Our goal is to make sure no one falls between the cracks by understanding the process (when and whom to refer for treatment). Guy was at this meeting and provided needed support. The CSA will also receive information about the PIHPs, such as their contact information. Larry asks members to invite the CSA to their meetings. We have asked the CSA to set-up meetings with the Prepaid Inpatient Health Plan Substance Abuse Prevention and Treatment Directors and Prevention Coordinators.

**Medicaid/Opioid Conference** – Attended a conference on Medicaid and Opioid entitled, *FY 2017 – Recommendations for Prescription Drug/Opioid Abuse Task Force - 2.10.16*. – Medicaid is focused on opioid related deaths, which include, 1) Opioid related deaths due to pain management, and 2) Deaths from opioid addiction from being in treatment. The meeting consisted of State Medicaid Directors and State Behavioral Health Administrators. More people are dying from methadone overdose related to pain more than any other opioid. When physicians and Medicaid Directors, except Michigan; were talking about prevention, it was about preventing overdose deaths due to overprescribing of pain medication and not primary prevention. SBIRT is not being implemented in most primary care settings.

#### **COLLABORATIVE PARTNER UPDATES**

- **MICHIGAN DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES (MDHHS) – Guy Thompson**  
Will be inviting regional staff that work in all those areas around the state and also work very close with families in various programs in both upper and Lower Michigan where we have parent partner programs. CPS and foster care will be reaching out. In addition, the Family Preservation Program and updates related to the Family Reunification Program will go statewide in October 1, 2016. The Parent Partner Program, which is only active in Wayne County, will also be expanded to an additional seven counties and will be posted. - **MICHIGAN DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION – Sarah Williams**

- **MICHIGAN STATE POLICE (OHSP) – Dianne Perukel**
- The University of Michigan will be doing a data dive for marijuana crashes, which we plan to publish. Let us know if any of you have questions. Will be available in about two months. There is a drug recognition expert training taking place. There will be 18 drug recognition experts added and 26 prosecutors. The Michigan State Police (MSP) will be testing the oral fluid test, which will be conducted by the drug recognition experts who will do the swabs.
- **PREVENTION NETWORK – Luanne Beaudry**  
Twenty-one (21) colleges want to be a part of the Higher Education Network established to create campus coalitions to address underage drinking and prescription drug abuse; awaiting 15 more. In two weeks call will be made to those we have not heard from. Information and resources have been sent out. We are in the relationship building process. Schools of Pharmacology want to be involved. The plan for the list is to have the group participate in a conference call and face-to-face meeting and a second conference call (a total of three (3) meetings). The group will participate by sending feedback on their needs. Engaging with resources that might be useful.

**PARTNERSHIP FOR SUCCESS (PFS) 2015-2020 UPDATE – Larry Scott and Liz Agius**

- **Overview**  
Year two is complete for the PFS continuation application, which will give us approval for funding into 2017. Since it is a five year plan, we have to apply each year for the following year funding. Tomorrow we have a meeting with Central CAPT to fine tune and lock down our training calendar for the year. The training is open to all of you and other partners. A calendar will be issued to you before the end of the month.
- **Deliverables**  
All except one PFS grantee submitted their strategic plan and we are expecting that one soon. Strategic plans are currently being reviewed. Would like your feedback by the 15th of February. Awaiting a list from Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) for town hall meetings. We are also reviewing the PFS first Quarterly Report. Larry says Liz is working on uploading (Community Level Instrument (CLI) and Grantee Level Instrument (GLI)) community data on progress made. Liz says they working on the system so you may enter data directly. Also waiting on Office of Management and Budget's (OMB) approval. Will send you a sample of last year's CLI so it may give you an idea of the types of questions. If you are a PFS 2015 grantee or sub target community, make sure you are actively entering in the Prevention Data System (PDS). Will be sending information to Larry about the youth survey and please actively push on getting it out. Timeline will be extended for the survey.
