Introductions and Welcome: Kelli opened the meeting and participants introduced themselves.

Approval of Agenda: Approved by consensus.

Minutes: The minutes of February 4, 2016 were reviewed and a change was requested to add region numbers to the roster for Prepaid Inpatient Health Plan attendees and remove old Coordinating Agency names.

OROSC UPDATES – Larry Scott

a. Overall updates

Request for Information (RFI) - Larry explained that funding for the strategic plan *RFI* have been issued to six (6) PIHPs. Out of a \$3.6M allocation, \$2.89M went to the six PIHPs and three went to PIHPs whose focus was prevention. There is no cap on funding.

Grant Applications – Currently vetting for three (3) grants;

- *Strategic Prevention Framework Prescription*, a five (5) year, \$371,000 per year grant.
- *Prescription Opioid Overdose*, a five (5) year, \$1M per year grant and it is competitive.
- *Capacity to Expand Medicated Assisted Treatment Services*, a three year grant, \$1M per year and also highly competitive. Eleven states will receive priority. Michigan is not among the 11 states.

All of these Grants may be viewed on www.grants.gov.

These grants are due May 31, 2016. A decision will be made next week about which ones we will apply for.

c. MICHIGAN STATE POLICE (MSP) – Dianne Perukel

The Michigan Traffic Crash Facts website is now “Live.” Still looking at the marijuana crash data that you will receive soon. Finished a Drug Recognition School and MSP now has Ninety-nine (99) drug recognition experts and 26 prosecutors, three as expert witnesses. The Legislature is still out on conducting oral fluid swab for drugs; will let you all know which counties are included. Meth is making a huge comeback everywhere in Michigan.

PARTNERSHIP FOR SUCCESS (PFS) 2015-2020 UPDATE – Kelli Martin, Liz Agius

a. Overview

The strategic parts have been reviewed with follow-up for a few items due on April 18, 2016. The GLI grantee document was submitted on time. Kelli and Rachel will continue to work with everyone to get ready to enter CLI data into the system. Rachel

will check on Lisa Coleman's log in status. Quarterly reports will be issued on the CLI. Brooke is converting the CLI document that will be ready by May 9.

b. Deliverables

Sub recipients are responsible for the CLI quarterly progress reports.

c. Central Data Repository (CDR) – Liz Agius

Liz projects an outline of the CDR on the screen for group to watch and explains new data, fixes. She will also send to group on the phone. For the 18-25 Survey there have been 800 responses. From 4/8 to 4/22/16, the survey will be relaunched on Facebook between the hours of 6:00 pm Saturday to 2:00 am on Sunday, as a center page ad, as well as mobile capability. She lets everyone know that significant data must be received from regions. The deadline is May 1, 2016.

d. Prevention Network (PN) – Luanne Beaudry

Luanne let everyone know the progress of the Higher Education Network established to create campus coalitions to address underage drinking and prescription drug abuse. Sixty-nine (69) contacts out of 33 colleges and contacts from all PIHPs are included.

e. Block Grant Spending

Larry responded to Jill's question regarding PFS spending and stated that PIHPs are allowed to spend more than 20% on prevention activities.

Region 1 – Northcare Network – Gery shared with the group that they are working with school based health clinics. Follow-up will take place.

OROSC – MDHHS - Larry shared that there will be a webinar on Integrating Prevention within a Primary Care Setting on April 26, 2016.

Region 7 - Detroit Wayne Mental Health Authority – Karra shared that training will take place at Wayne State for coalitions to be trained on SBIRT.
