SUMMARY OF KEY POINTS

Introductions and Welcome: Larry opened the meeting and participants introduced themselves. Attendance attached.

Approval of Agenda: Approved unanimously by consensus.

Minutes: The minutes of October 1, 2015 were reviewed and approved unanimously by consensus.

OROSC Updates – Larry Scott and Rachel Kollin

Reported on deliverables required for the *Partnership for Success (PFS) 2015-2020 Notice of Award (NOA) Terms and Conditions* including a *Disparities Impact Statement* and an evaluation plan. Provided an update on the *Michigan Youth Treatment Infrastructure Enhancement Grant (MYTIE)* including the status of deliverables to be submitted to meet the *NOA Terms and Conditions*. Reported on the status of filling staff position for the PFS 2015-2020 Grant Project. Posting for the MYTIE director position is eminent. Provided an update on the recommendations of the Governor’s *Michigan Prescription and Opioid Task Force*, specifically, the recommendations that are specific to prevention. The work of the PFS Grant Projects including the “Do Your Part” media campaign are in synch with the Task Force recommendations. Implementation of some of the recommendations by OROSC are anticipated. An overview of the results of a survey conducted by OROSC to discern the level collaboration between PIHP’s and Child and Adolescent Health Centers was shared. Most of the PIHPs have either provided clinical and prevention services at the Health Centers or have collaborated with the Health Centers on prevention initiatives. A handout featuring a comparison of recreational marijuana laws enacted by the state of Washington and Colorado. OROSC staff met with the *Central Center for the Application of Prevention Technologies* staff to plan the fiscal year 2016 training calendar for PFS 2015-2020 Grantees. Training will focus on infrastructure development and innovative practices.

- **Collaborative Partner Updates**

MICHIGAN DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES (MDHHS) – Guy Thompson

New *Pathway to Potential* sites are being added across the state. Success coaches continue to be employed in the Pathway to Potential and Home Services sites the Families First Program are providing a focus on the reunification of families affected by Child Protective Services. Substance use disorder prevention and treatment are integrated into the service plan for families. For evidence-based practices on the prevention of domestic violence, a training on the David Mandel was recommended.

Michigan Department of Education – Sarah Williams

MiPHY Enhancements are currently underway. MDE is also working on a State-level Strategic Plan to integrate projects including Safe Schools Healthy Students; Project Aware and School Climate Transformation.

Screening Brief Intervention and Referral to Treatment

Update on local activities: Macomb County Community Mental Health is on its 3rd or 4th year of monthly overviews to PIHP staff on SBIRT designed for 18-20 year olds. Southwest Michigan Behavioral Health provides SBIRT at its Family Health Centers including screening with referral to PIHP for assessment and brief intervention and referral to Prime for Life for persons in need of prevention services, or treatment for those who meet the diagnosis for dependence. At Oakland County Community Mental Health, SBIRT is provided at FQHCs.

Substance Abuse Prevention Skills Training (SAPST)

Update on local activities: Lisa Coleman from Region 10 PIHP and Ken Dail from Prevention Michigan will conduct a SAPST Training in Lansing January 19-22, 2016 and in Detroit in February, 2016.
