#### SUMMARY OF KEY POINTS

##### **SEOW Meeting Approval of Agenda/Minutes - J. Hoepfner**

- Agenda for today's meeting was reviewed and approved by consensus. The minutes of November 18, 2015 were reviewed and approved by consensus.

##### **OROSC Updates – Larry Scott**

- **Michigan Health Disparities** - paying close attention to data that illustrates health disparities in MI, both on mental, physical, as well as behavioral, including SUD and primary care. Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) of all categorical grants are requiring all applicants' states to submit a disparities impact statement, which will force applicants to look at a) data current collecting regarding health disparities, and b) make amends to fill the gaps and data collection, and c) report on the data in a meaningful fashion. Our office will be diligent and stay on top of health disparities within various population's and this will be a primary selection criteria for discretionary grants. Also, as we update our guidelines to the Prepaid Inpatient Health Plans (PIHP) for the coming year for the updating of their strategic plans that they identify health disparity gaps within their catchment areas. If anyone has any ideas, this subject can be a standing discussion item for this group.

Su Min will bring target indicators from SPF2015 and add to next month's agenda. We have to be able to tell a story about prevention and treatment. Larry suggests this as a publishing strategy to have an idea of where the services are needed.

- **Senate Bill** - The senate passed a bill today that allows Michigan State Police (MSP) that are trained/certified to identify substance use issues to conduct a pilot in five selected communities for roadside drug testing. After the one-year pilot project, the MSP has to create a statistical report on their findings; frequency, demographics, controlled substances, etc. This will be a useful tool in planning for prevention.
- **Governor's Task Force Recommendations** – A great deal of attention will be given to mandate physicians to register for MAPS

##### **Emerging Issues and Trends**

##### **Opioids, Prescription Drugs, Heroin, Marijuana, E-Cigarettes - Su Min Oh**

- **Prescription Drugs** – E-Mailed an article to everyone by Dr. Bret Bielawski who is our consulting member.
- **Various** – Ingham has various marketing items going out on Facebook and Twitter feeds, such as MAT, heroin overdose deaths, Naloxone, etc. MPA puts out a legislative update where all the bills that are going forward that relate to substance use disorder services and or issues. Ask Mike Tobias from PN to be added to the list.  
**Region 6** – Expended numerous efforts, such as project LAZARUS, etc. Attempting to create a tracking system long/short term on pounds selected, such as REDBOX, Lock Your Meds, etc., and what we are going to implement as a result of the data.
- **Heroin** – Just received the latest data and will share at the next meeting.
- **Legalizing Marijuana** – Rachel will report at the next meeting.
- **E-cigarettes** – No new information nor movement.

Prevention Network has shared with their coalitions. To increase the numbers more effectively, partner with community colleges, colleges, and workforce developments sites, such as Michigan Works who interact with 18-21 year olds.

Liz will consult with Nick about adding two or maybe one tab that says “News” or “SEOW Highlights.” Larry suggests posting to the latest ROSC Newsletter along with the link. We will see how we can share our identified stakeholders to include Mary Ludtke and Epidemiology and any ideas they offer. Joel asks for thoughts from other members.
