MDOT Local Agency Programs (LAP), in cooperation the Michigan Section of Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and the Michigan County Road Association (CRA) has completed updates to the three program application forms that local agencies complete and forward to LAP as part of the grade inspection submittal. These three forms, MDOT Forms 0258, 0259, and 0260, were modified to include a Railroad Coordination Certification section.

This certification is similar to the certification required for MDOT trunkline projects. For local agency projects, the local agency certifies that it will coordinate its construction project with any railroad project that is located within the limits of the local agency project.

The updated forms, dated 05/15 in the form header, are available immediately on the LAP website (www.michigan.gov/mdotlap), in the "Forms" link on the individual pages for each LAP Unit.

All local agencies should begin using these forms with the next project that it submits to LAP. Projects that LAP has received as of May 5, 2015 can use the previous edition of the programming application forms.
