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Consultant Advisory
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E- Verify Requirements for Consultants

On June 26, 2012, Governor Snyder signed Public Act 200 of 2012, Section 381, which states: "as a condition of each contract or subcontract for construction, maintenance, or engineering services that the pre-qualified contractor or subcontractor agree to use the E-Verify system to verify that all persons hired during the contract term by the contractor or subcontractor are legally present and authorized to work in the United States."

Effective with all projects posted beginning November 1, 2012, the Department will be including a Notification into each proposal briefly describing the requirements of the E-Verify program. It will be the responsibility of the prime consultant to include the requirements in this Notification in all tiers of subcontracts.

The Department will also be adding a certification statement to the "Certification Affidavit" section, in the Consultant Prequalification Application, stating that the consultant has/will use the E-verify System.

In addition, the subcontract boilerplate has also been amended to include E-Verify language in the Certification section. This language must be included in all subcontracts.

The documentation supporting the usage of the E-Verify system must be maintained by each consultant and be made available to MDOT upon request.
