Small Business Program

MDOT is implementing its Consultant Small Business Program (SBP). The SBP is a race- and gender-neutral program designed to provide consultant opportunities for small businesses on projects funded in whole or in part by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA), Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and Federal Transit Administration (FTA). This program is required by federal regulation 49 CFR Part §26.39.

Beginning this summer, MDOT plans to advertise projects that will require the prime consultant to be approved as a small business. In order to be eligible to submit proposals on these projects, a firm must submit an SBP application (Form 4106) at least 30 days prior to the proposal due date. The applications must be submitted to the following address:
