What is the 2040 MI Transportation Plan?

The 2040 MI Transportation Plan (2040 MITP) is the state long-range transportation plan for Michigan. The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) is updating the 2040 MITP to include essential components that will move Michigan forward.

The 2040 MITP is an extension of previous long-range plans, and serves as the strategic vision for the future of an integrated, multimodal transportation system. The 2040 MITP offers an update on issues and data that are critical to transportation, and describes new actions taken to further Michigan's transportation goals. Key plan components include:

- A clear, supported vision for Michigan's transportation future.
- The transportation system is the backbone of Michigan's economy.
- Michigan's economy is improving and is resulting in a greater use of the system.
- New state and federal legislation will provide five years of predictable and stable transportation investment.
- The transportation system will continue to evolve and modernize with changing demographics, new technologies and use of connected and autonomous vehicles.
