From Ann Arbor: I-23 North to I-96 West, to US-127 (exit 106) North to Trowbridge Road exit East to Harrison Road; turn left North approx. 1 mile on the right.

From Charlotte: North on I-69 to I-496 East; East to Trowbridge Road (exit 9) East to Harrison Road; turn left North approx. 1 mile on the right.

From Detroit: I-96 West to US-127 (exit 106) North to Trowbridge Road exit East to Harrison Road; turn left North approx. 1 mile on the right.

From Eaton Rapids: M-99 to I-96 East to US-127 (exit 106) North to Trowbridge Road exit East to Harrison Road; turn left North approx. 1 mile on the right.

From Flint: West on I-69 to US-127 (exit 89) South to Trowbridge Road exit East to Harrison Road; turn left North approx. 1 mile on the right.

From Grand Rapids: East on I-96 to I-496 (exit 95) East to Trowbridge Road (exit 9) East to Harrison Road; turn left North approx. 1 mile on the right.

From Kalamazoo: I-94 East to I-69 North, to I-496 East; East to Trowbridge Road (exit 9) East to Harrison Road; turn left North approx. 1 mile on the right.

From St. Johns: South on US-27 to US-127 South to Trowbridge Road exit East to Harrison Road; turn left North approx. 1 mile on the right.
