

MDOT Training Wheels On-Road Bicycle Facility Design Training

Training Wheels is an educational course on the planning and design of on-road bicycle facilities. It will consist of two hours of classroom instruction on the AASHTO Guide for the Development of Bicycle Facilities, followed by an on-road, **on bike portion**. During this portion we will casually ride through the community, analyzing types of on-road facilities available. There will be many stops to point out potential facility types, followed by lunch and a classroom design exercise, questions from participants and a brief wrap-up.

Class is intended to accommodate all levels of users. If special accommodations are required, please notify host community a minimum of 2 weeks in advance. Please dress appropriately as we will bike, rain or shine.

Class Size: Maximum of 25

Continuing Education Credits: This course is eligible for five (5.5) Professional Development Hours (PDH) for Professional Engineers (PE). Certified Planners may self-report up to five (5.5) Certification Maintenance (CM) hours.

Instructors: This year instructors come to us from T.Y. Lin International:

Tim Gustafson, AICP, is a Senior Transportation Planner with T.Y. Lin International. He brings extensive knowledge of bicycle transportation issues and has over 10 years' experience. Mr. Gustafson has served as Training Wheels Course Instructor for several years.

Nate Roseberry, P.E., is a Senior Transportation Engineer with T.Y. Lin International and possesses 12 years' experience in the transportation field. Currently, Mr. Roseberry manages the design engineering program for the Chicago Department of Transportation (CDOT) bicycle program, focused on the more than 250-mile network planned as part of the Chicago Bike 2020 Plan.

Required Materials: A bicycle and helmet are required. Please let host know if you need assistance in obtaining these for the class.
