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
National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) and Soil Erosion and Sedimentation Control (SESC), Inspection Report, Form 1126

Form 1126, Inspection Report, was updated in February 2014 after discussions with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA). The revised 1126 form must be used when documenting SESC inspections and this requirement is listed on the form. In several instances construction staff was placing SESC inspection notes solely in an Inspector's Daily Report (IDR). Comments in an IDR may be incorporated as further documentation, but all SESC comments must be documented on form 1126.
