

The manual has been revised to reflect the current state of practice and changes made for the 2012 Standard Specifications for Construction. The numbering convention for the various divisions has been updated to bring it into alignment with the 2012 Standard Specifications for Construction. Several sections have been reorganized to present the material in a more orderly manner, making information easier to find.

Other benefits of the Wiki format and internet based formats in general are the ability to share information using various media (video, presentations, etc.) and to link or reference various other sources of information on the internet.

Additionally, the Construction Manual incorporates the MDOT Documentation Guide (Minimum Acceptance Requirements for Materials approvals and Documentation).

The new Construction Manual will not be available in print; however, if a page is needed, such as use of a table in the field, you can print from the menu options in your web browser.
