Orientation 101: DBE Orientation

**Owners of new and recertifying Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBEs)
must attend DBE Orientation.**

In order to successfully bid as a new or recertifying firm, the disadvantaged owner(s) and/or company officer(s) must attend Orientation. To receive credit, attendees must stay for the entire duration of the program. Other key employees of DBE firms are encouraged to register, especially those who are vital to your firm's advancement.

Feel free to dress business casual as this is an interactive session where you will receive valuable information about MDOT's contracting, bidding processes and Support Services Program. We will answer frequently asked questions as well as take time to hear and respond to your specific questions and concerns as we discuss the following:
