

Project's Objectives & Aesthetic Themes


The following objectives have been established to support the overall project goal as part of MDOT's Context Sensitive Solutions process which includes public and agency involvement throughout the project.

1. Ensure compatibility with community character and values.
2. Ensure compatibility with existing community themes and/or aesthetics.
3. Minimize disruption.
4. Provide for a gateway entrance for motorized and non-motorized transportation into the community at the Cooper Road Interchange.
5. Develop a landscaping theme for the I-94 corridor.
