What Is Being Done?


Starting in March, the Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) will replace the Trumbull Avenue bridge over I-94 in Detroit.

How Will Traffic Be Affected?

Motorists should expect one lane of I-94 closed in each direction under Trumbull Avenue during the overnight hours (8 p.m. - 5 a.m.) on weekdays and at all times on weekends. Any double-lane closures will be limited to overnight hours on weekends. The northbound and southbound M-10 ramps to westbound I-94 will be closed when there is a double-lane closure at Trumbull Avenue.

I-94 will be closed in each direction between I-96 and M-10 (Lodge Freeway) when crews demolish the current bridge and when they set beams for the new bridge. These closures will take place from 10 p.m. Friday until 5 a.m. Monday when this work occurs. MDOT will announce these closures in advance.

During the Trumbull Avenue bridge closure, the eastbound I-94 exit ramp to Trumbull Avenue and the Trumbull Avenue entrance ramp to westbound I-94 will be closed as well.

How Will Trumbull Avenue Traffic Be Affected?


Beginning this spring, Trumbull Avenue will be closed over I-94 to all vehicular and nonmotorized traffic.

Northbound Trumbull Avenue traffic will be detoured to westbound Warren Avenue, then northbound Rosa Parks Boulevard to eastbound Holden Street.

Southbound Trumbull Avenue will be detoured to westbound West Grand Boulevard, then to southbound 14th Street to eastbound Forest Avenue.

Eastbound I-94 traffic to Henry Ford Hospital will exit westbound I-96 to Grand Boulevard and head east.

Henry Ford Hospital traffic to westbound I-94 will use westbound Grand Boulevard to eastbound I-96.
