

M-10 under Martin Luther King Blvd, Wayne County Design Build Information Sheet

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) intends on using a Design-Build procurement method to deliver a bridge replacement and roadway/ramp improvements. MDOT plans to issue a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) in early October and releasing the Request for Proposals (RFP) in early December. The project letting is expected to be let in late January and construction is expected to be substantially complete by September 2017.

The project is located in Wayne County and is located on M-10 at Martin Luther King Boulevard. The project will replace the MLK over M-10 structure and extend the deceleration lane south of MLK Boulevard. The ramp extension will include retaining wall relocation/modification. The Southbound M-10 ramp to Grand River/Temple will be widened along with some minor intersection improvements.

A DBE goal will be established for this project, but hasn't been determined at this time.
